

Burglary

At 8:10pm, July 3, an ACCPD officer on patrol in the Vine Street area saw a subject that he knew had outstanding warrants walking onto the property of Vine East Apartments, 524 Vine Street. In a search incidental to his arrest, it was discovered that MATTOX was also in possession of crack cocaine and a glass "shooter" pipe. He was also charged for the drug and paraphernalia possession. A subsequent search yielded a Mason Jar containing a quantity of suspected marijuana, as well as a rolled marijuana cigarette and a small plastic baggy of marijuana. Approximately \$550.00 was visible in the center console area. The driver, Brittany Nicole TATE, 26, Fourth Street, Athens, was arrested and charged with Possession of Marijuana With Intent to Distribute and Open Container of Alcohol in vehicle. Motor Vehicle Accident With Injuries

At 8:06am, July 3, Jeffery Bernard FOOTE, 49, Garnett Ward Road, Hull, GA, was traveling westbound on GA 72/Hull Road, operating a 2001 Chevrolet Blazer.
