Other Points of Note

- 274 out of the 357 homeless individuals and families claimed Athens as their origin of homelessness (76%)
- 156 out of 357 or 44% have employment income either Part time or Full time (89 part-time, and 67 fulltime)
- 41 out of 357 have income from Social Security, SSI or SSDI (11.4%)
- 11 out of 357 have income from TANF or Vet Benefits (3%)
- 45 out of 357 are currently receiving Food Stamp assistance (13%)
- 89 out of 357 claimed no income source (25%)
 - approximately 5 percent refused to give this information or it was unknown based on their client file
