Other Points of Note

- 228 out of the 364 homeless individuals and families claimed Athens as their origin of homelessness (63%)
- 141 out of 364 or 39% of homeless individuals and families have employment income either Part time or Full time (85 part-time, and 56 fulltime)
- 46 out of 364 have income from Social Security, SSI or SSDI (12.5%)
- 8 out of 364 have income from TANF or Vet Benefits (2%)
- 40 out of 364 are currently receiving Food Stamp assistance (11%)
- 122 out of 364 claimed no income source (33.5%)
 - approximately 5 percent refused to give this information or it was unknown based on their client file
