MACIAS HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

On August 13, 2016, at 2:38 am, Daniel Macias, 28, of Athens, Georgia, suffered multiple fatal gunshot wounds while in the downtown area of Athens at the intersection of Hancock Ave and Jackson St. A continuing investigation by the Athens-Clarke County Police Department and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, to include the review of hundreds of hours of surveillance videos and interviewing numerous potential witnesses, has not revealed the identity of the suspect at this time.

STEVENS HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

On August 16, 2016, at 11:09 am, Athens-Clarke County Police responded to a 911 caller (victim) advising that he had been shot and was located behind an apartment at 205 Gaines School Rd. Responding police officers located Daimayan Stevens, 29, of Athens, Georgia, collapsed of a gunshot wound. Stevens' wound would prove to be fatal as he was pronounced deceased at Athens Regional Medical Center within the hour. It was determined that Stevens was shot inside of a nearby apartment where he had been residing. An investigation by Athens-Clarke County Police has not determined if there were any witnesses to the actual shooting. Numerous people have been identified and interviewed that were present just prior to and/or after the incident occurred. No suspect has been identified at this time.
