Burgundy Court Home Invasion

On January 7th at approximately 9:30 p.m. officers with the Athens-Clarke County Police Department responded to a residence off of Burgundy Court in reference to an armed robbery. The victim stated she went to open the front door after hearing someone knock. When she opened the door, a masked man carrying a black handgun forced his way inside. He asked her “where is the money” and “where was her son”. The victim was home alone. The suspect forced the victim into a closet and rummaged through several rooms. He took the victim’s wallet that contained \$200.00 in cash. He also took a safe that contained \$3400.00 in cash, some jewelry and two handguns. He threatened the victim as he was leaving. The victim remained in the closet for approximately 15 minutes before coming out and calling 911. The victim was not able to provide any other information about the suspect.
