Woman Stabbed During Altercation

On February 17, 2017, at approximately 8:20 pm, officers responded to a fight in progress at Rolling Ridge Apartments. While officers were in route to the scene they were advised that multiple subjects were involved and one person had been stabbed. The investigation found that as Lee Elder, B/F 35-years-old, out of Athens, was entering into Rolling Ridge Apartments she was approached by several women who began to try and start a physical altercation.

Lee Elder was in possession of a pocket knife and held it up to protect herself. At this point, one of the females involved, Kim Reaves, B/F 27-years-old, out of South Carolina, began swinging at and striking Lee Elder. It was during this point when Kim Reaves received a single stab wound to the chest. Kim Reaves was transported to a local hospital, and taken into emergency surgery. As of Friday night, Kim was in ICU and listed in critical condition. Lee Elder also sustained injuries during the altercation (lacerated hand) and was transported to a local hospital. No arrests have been made in this case at this time, and this continues to be an active investigation.
