One man stabbed, one shot during altercation

On 04/20/2017 around 1:00 pm officers responded to Broadacres Court in reference to a shooting. Upon the officer's arrival on scene, they began treating a man with a gunshot wound to his thigh. The victim stated that his current girlfriend's former boyfriend, Travius Bugg came to the residence to pick up some of his belongings. Soon after his arrival, Travius physically assaulted the victim and a struggle ensued. During this struggle, Travius pulled a gun and shot the victim in the thigh. The victim stated he utilized a knife in self-defense and cut the suspect several times about the face. Travius left the residence before officer's arrived on scene and was later found at a local hospital receiving medical treatment for his wounds. The investigation conducted by detectives determined that Travius was the primary aggressor. After receiving medical treatment he was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault with a gun, Battery (Misd), and possession of a weapon during the commission of a crime.
