Waffle House Armed Robbery

On 08/15/2017 at just after 2:00 am, officers with the Athens-Clarke County police department were dispatched to 1310 Oconee Street (Waffle House) in reference to an Armed Robbery that had just occurred. Officers were told by employees (2) and customers (3) that two black males wearing masks entered the store, one of them armed with a handgun, and ordered everyone to the ground. The suspects then began to take property from the customers (purses and cell phones) and money from the cash register.

The suspect who was armed was described as wearing a black ski mask, black shirt, camouflage shorts and white shoes. The second suspect was described as wearing a black ski mask, black t-shirt, black pants, and black tennis shoes. The Athens-Clarke County forensic unit was called to the scene to process evidence and this continues to be an ongoing investigation.
