### **Pursuit Begins due to Shots Being Fired**

On September 30 at just after 10:00 pm, officers were in the area of West Broad Street and Minor Street. Officers heard and saw several shots and witnessed a group of people running on Minor St as if fleeing something. A vehicle was seen speeding away from the area. Officers pursued the vehicle, a red in color Nissan Versa. The chase continued into Oglethorpe County where the suspects stopped after a failed P.I.T attempt by an Oglethorpe Deputy. Four suspects were apprehended and arrested.
