One Man Shot During Home Invasion

On 11/25/2017, at approximately 10:00 pm, officers were dispatched to a location off Wellington Ct. Upon their arrival on scene, the occupants in the residence told them that three suspects entered the residence demanding money. There were possibly 5-6 occupants including an 8-year-old child. One of the residents was shot in the calf. The wound was a through-and-through wound and did not appear to be life threatening.

Other occupants detained one of the non-shooting suspects, Larry Ebron, while the shooter and other suspect fled the scene. Ebron received significant injuries while being subdued by the occupants of the residence. The victim and Ebron were both transported to a local hospital. The other two suspects involved were identified as black males.

Ebron was charged with Home Invasion and Aggravated Assault. Anyone with any information on the other two suspects is asked to contact Detective Paul Johnson at 706-613-3330 ext. 522.
