Old West Broad Street Home Invasion

On 12/28/17 at approximately 11:45 p.m. officers were dispatched to a possible burglary in progress on Old West Broad Street. While in route, they were advised that a female victim stated, the suspects were armed and they made her lie on the ground.

Upon their arrival on scene, officers spoke to one of the victims involved, and he stated that he heard male voices coming from the back of the residence and after hearing the voices, he heard someone kicking the back door. The door was kicked several times before he went over and turned the doorknob. He said that he didn't open the door, he just turned the knob and then someone kicked it again, and it opened. Three black males entered the residence; one was armed with a gun and the other a taser. The description of the males provided are: Male #1 was a thin, light-skinned black male with reddish colored facial hair, wearing a blue hoodie, and carrying a silver gun, Male #2 was a heavysset black male wearing a blue hoodie, blue sweat style pants and was armed with a taser. Male #3 was simply described as a black male. Male #2 went through the bedroom, "flipping the bed." The complaint stated, his girlfriend, and a small child were in the residence with him when this incident occurred.
