8 Arrests, 2 Warrants Issued for Gang Related Shootings

Since the beginning of 2018, ACCPD has investigated 14 shooting incidents that are believed to be gang-related. These incidents have primarily involved members and associates of local Bloods and Crips criminal street gangs. Two individuals have been shot during these shootings, property has been damaged, and human life has been placed at risk.

As of 4/4/2018, Investigators have arrested eight (8) offenders, secured warrants on two (2) additional offenders, and have been able to tie them to 6 of the 14 shootings. They continue to work on identifying connections in the remaining shootings. Investigators also believe that more individuals could be involved and will continue their efforts to identify them. Additionally, firearms have been seized as evidence in these arrests.

Although Detectives asked for no bond stipulations due to the violent nature of the crimes and the propensity for repeat offences, several suspects have bonded out. ACCPD will continue to work hard and utilize all resources necessary to hold those accountable who indiscriminately place human life at risk.
