ACCPD Investigating Possible Abduction

On Tuesday July 31st at approximately 9:00 pm, Officers responded to the front entrance of Georgia Square Mall near Zaxby's. The caller advised that he was outside the business when he heard a female yelling from the front entrance road near the Atlanta Highway. The victim was being dragged by her hoodie towards the intersection with the mall perimeter road. The victim was yelling "He's taking me" repeatedly according to the witness. She was being dragged by a black male, who was approximately 6' tall and 190 pounds towards a late model burgundy 4 door Cadillac sedan, possibly a CTS. The man threw her into the back seat of the Cadillac and got in behind her. The vehicle departed and was last seen driving towards the Huntington Road exit of the mall.

According to the witness, the subject was wearing a uniform with a lighter color shirt than the pants. The shirt was either gray or blue and possibly has stripes on the shirtsleeves. The suspect was wearing a duty belt but the witness did not see a firearm.

The female was described as a black female in her late teens, 5' 5" tall, and weighing between 120 and 130 pounds. She was wearing a light-colored hoodie and dark jeans.
